
### Physical reopening for Grades 9 and 11

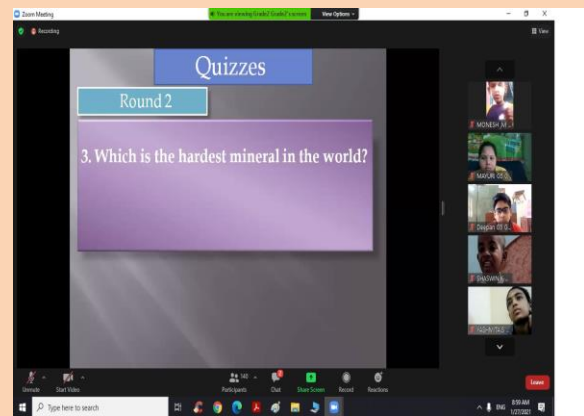
## QUIZ WEEK

## Grade 2 Assembly:

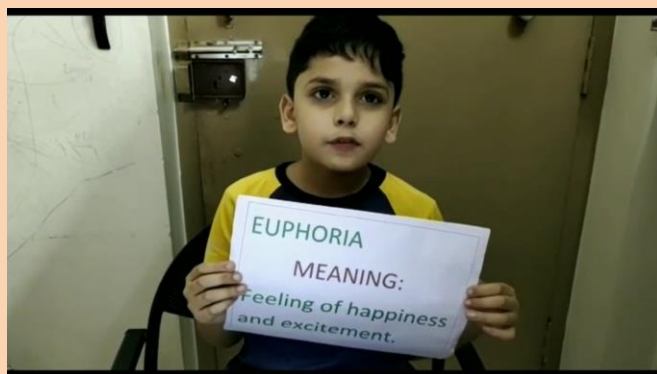

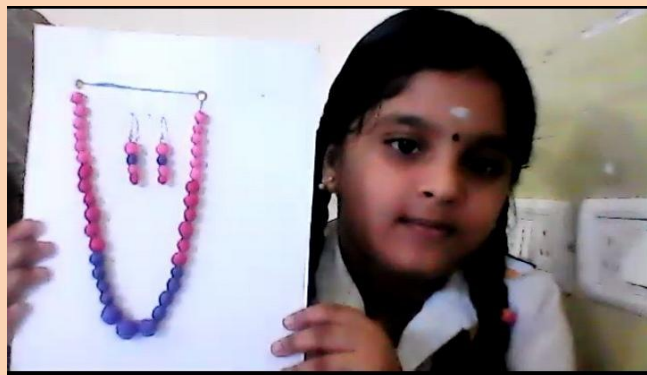
Overall, the energy of the assembly performances was contagious which left the viewers in awe of them! And at last, the assembly came to an end with the National Anthem.

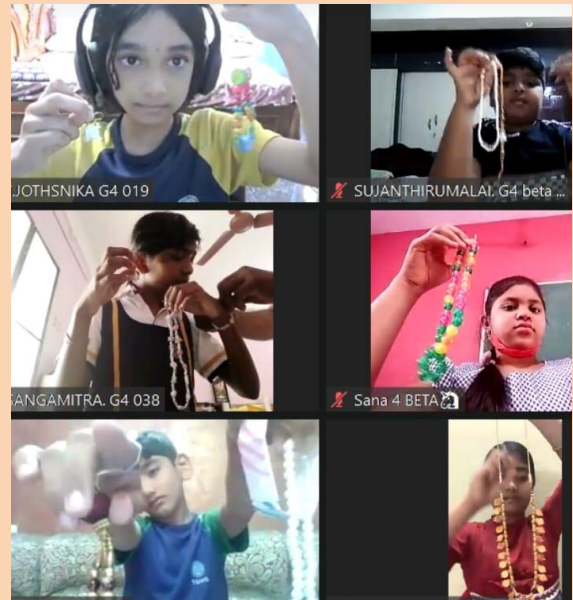

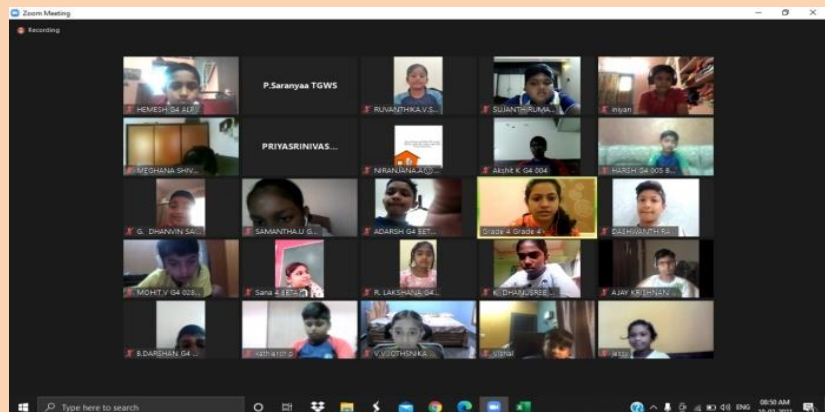
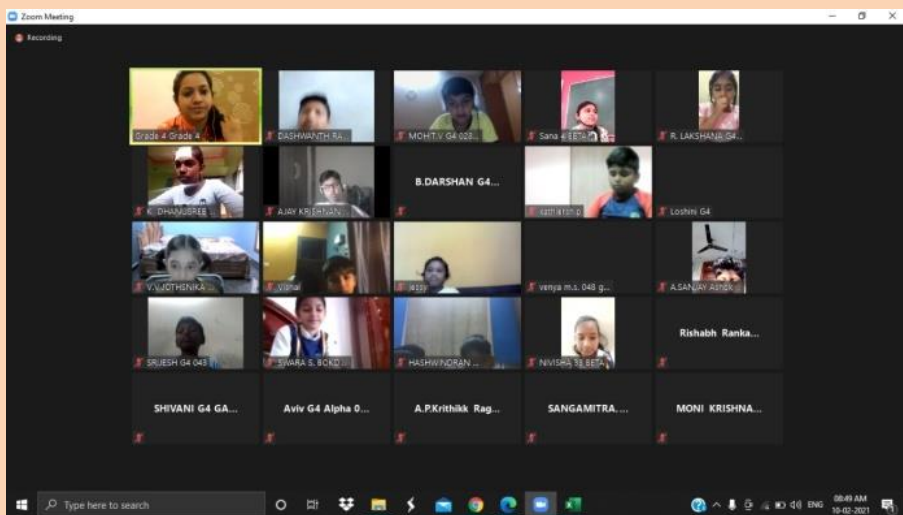
The home online IBT test for this year was conducted as per the following schedule;

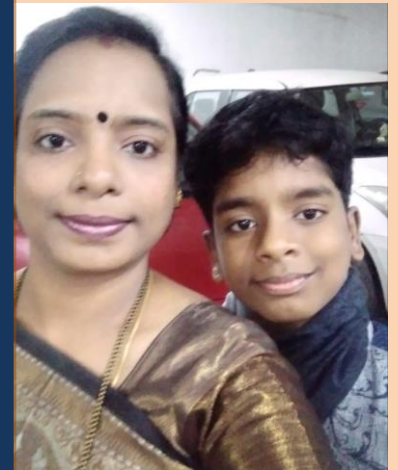

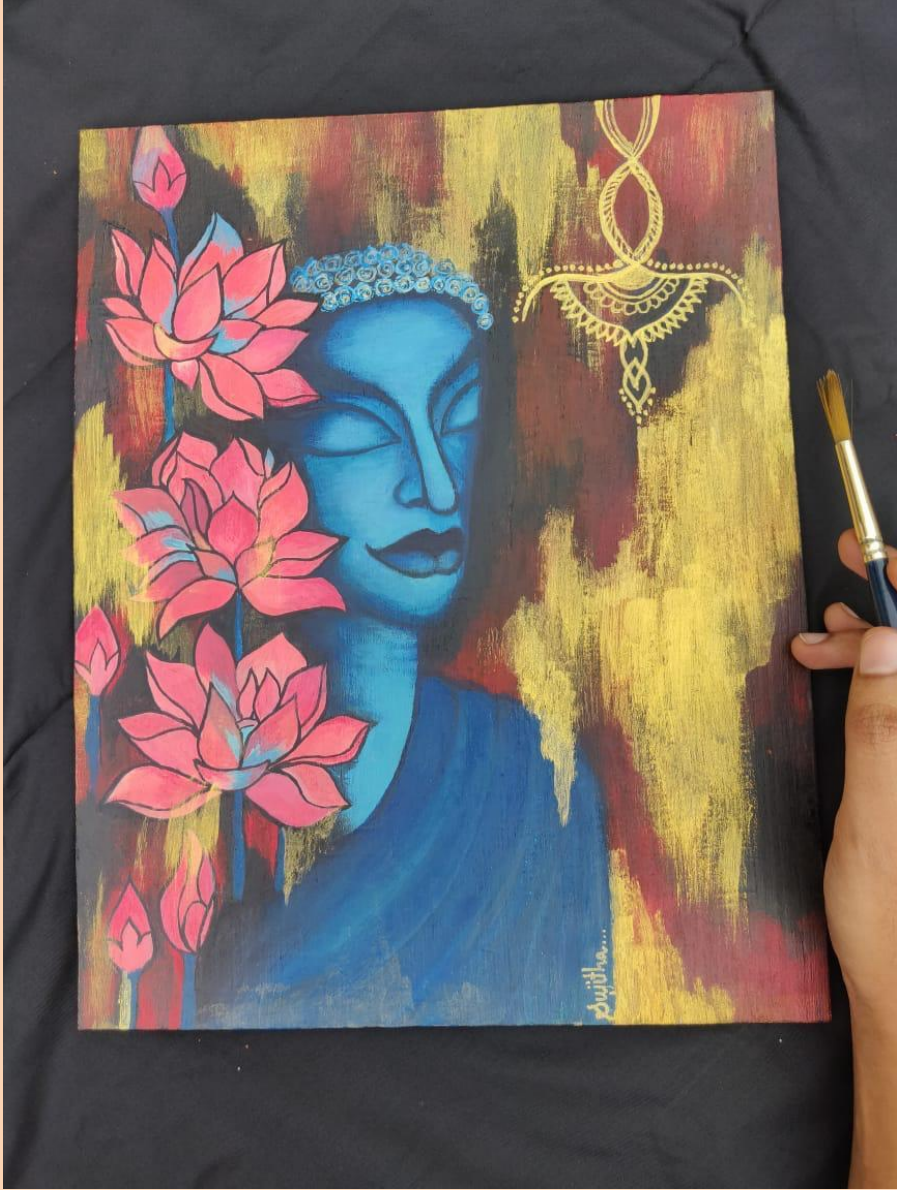
